



Label Environment Guide

The following information is a guide only, if you're not sure what type of label would best suit your particular application contact Peter Laws for advice.

It is highly recommend that the user conduct a test of surface preparation and label adhesion before ordering labels.



Mild

Indoor conditions with average temperatures and possible minor exposure to some gentle chemicals and cleaning products.

Uses might include *general office, education and library fixed assets.*



Moderate

Most suited to indoor and outdoor use when conditions have moderate or intermittent exposure to some common temperate chemicals, cleaning solutions and temperatures.

Uses might include *healthcare, education, warehouse control and in-plant fixed assets.*



Extreme

Harsh indoor/outdoor or extreme industrial conditions with exposure to some or all of the following: abrasion, caustics/acids, solvents and extreme temperature variations.

Uses might include *oil & gas refineries & offshore rigs, aeronautical, defence, hospitals, laboratories, manufacturing facilities, volatile emissions tracking and tool control.*

Utilities: *water and gas meters, electricity, telecommunications and cable poles*
